I tried them on an old set of Navigators and they proved to be as good as the manufacturers claim as, despite clattering my arrows and breaking a pin nock, the vanes were unmarked. Unfortunately, being so long, they are significantly slower than my normal spin wings which means they won't be much use much above 60 yards.

Speaking to one of the club members this week I was told that at Lilleshall they no longer teach beginners barebow technique on week one but start straight away with an open hand, Mediterranean hold and jaw line anchor point method. Bill – isn't it good to be proven correct.
